## **Activities Section Writing Tips**

- Avoid starting all or any sentences with "I"
- Use compelling words
- Avoid writing things that your profile already shows (i.e., I'm a Junior, I'm a high school student, I want to go to college...)
- Consider including a question or quote
- Think like your reader. What do they want to know? Why do you stand out?
- Include links if they are helpful (i.e., your Hudl.com, your website, so forth)

## Check, Check & Double Check!

- · Capitalize: Your name, your school, all proper nouns, your sentences
- Spelling: Yes, it counts!
- Sentences: All make sense (read them aloud)
- Your links: Do they work?
- Your settings: Are you discoverable?
